Evocative and personal, artwork provides an emotional link to colour that's ripe for repeating



Artwork certainly adds a sense of personality to your space. "It's a focal point. It should be thought provoking," says Sean Morris of Urban Interior. Without going over the top, use your art as colour inspiration. "Go to a paint shop and pick out all the common colour chips that appear, so you have a tangible reference and a palette you can build on," says Prue Royle from the International School of Colour and Design. This artwork (above) influences the tones that are followed through in the bedding. Subtlety is the key! Tie your art into your room with a simple piece that picks up on the work's dominant hue.
