



## MEDIUM -TONED *floorboards*

**TIMBER FLOORS** such as tallowwood, gums and ironbark have a medium brown tone that's

common in popular furniture so if you're working with existing pieces in these shades, break up the brown with rug designs that are bold and eye-catching yet sympathetic to your floor colour. We think rich deep reds and neutral shades complement brown tones best, so rugs made

of natural materials like jute, sisal, seagrass, hemp, wool and cotton work well. Pick bold designs and inject subtle, rich organic colours into interiors with your rug selection. Keep your future furniture selections in plain white or light-tones and minimise the timber colours in the space. →
